Wrap Around Childcare

We are pleased to say that we are opening our after school wrap around provision from the start of next term. The provision is being run and managed by school and the two staff who are joining us to staff the provision are Ms Shelley and Mrs Blackie. Mrs Blackie has been volunteering and providing some cover in school this term already. The provision will run from the end of the school day until 6pm and will be based in our community room. Please use this form [Wrap Around After School Childcare - Expression of Interest - Fill in form](#) to express an interest in a place for you child, or children, in our Wrap Around Childcare provision. The provision is open to all children on roll at Birtley East Primary School provided there is capacity in the provision. We reserve the right to particularly restrict the number of places offered to Early Years children if ratio has been reached. Please refer to our charging policy (extract below) regarding the cost of the childcare. All sessions booked MUST be paid for regardless of whether your child attends. There will be a further registration form for you to complete following this initial expression of interest, this will be sent to you next week. This initial form is to enable us to plan early next week for the numbers and ages of children we can expect after Christmas so that the club can open as soon as we return for the start of the spring term, please complete this as early as you can in order to help with our planning meeting on Tuesday 16th December.





After school childcare	Reception - Y6 Possibility of places for nursery children dependant upon capacity.*	£10 for whole session (end of school day - 6pm) £5 for part session (end of after school club - 6pm) Payable half termly in advance
<p>Children can attend either the full session (at a charge of £10 per night) or a half session (attending after an after school club) for £5 per night. Unless children are attending an after school club the full £10 charge will apply regardless of the time they are collected. Children collected late (after 6pm) will incur a £10 late collection charge.</p> <p>Additionally, children who are late being collected from school at either home time or after an after school club will be placed in the wrap around provision and this will incur a £5 charge for that night (or a £10 charge if they attend the full session). There will be a grace period of 10 minutes before this is applied.</p>		

*Initially, we will be offering places to nursery children but we will stop admitting nursery children when we reach ratio for Early Years.

After School Clubs next week

All after school clubs next week will run as normal with the exception of Drama club and Forest School club - these clubs both finish this week, there will be no sessions next week.

The arrangements are the same as previous years - children in years 1-6 should come to school in school uniform with party clothes to change into at lunchtime as their parties are during the afternoon. Children should bring a party tea packed for them to eat towards the end of their party. We will provide drinks. Miss Coxon will let you know about any specific arrangements for the Early Years party but these will be similar to the rest of the school with the exception that children in Early Years come to school dressed in their party clothes. We cannot accommodate parents coming to change their children during lunchtime and we would strongly discourage parents from taking their children home to change over lunchtime as it is actually part of the party experience to all get ready together, they get very excited!
