Sports Day - Y1-6

Y6 Residential

The Year 6 children are very excited about their upcoming residential. Please ensure your child has all of the items on the kit list packed and if there are any issues, please let us know ASAP. They will also need a backpack, water bottle and lunch for the first day, unless you have ordered a school packed lunch - in that case they will only need a water bottle and backpack. Children should come to school at the normal time but if your child needs to take medication, can you please complete a consent form and hand the medication to an adult at drop off:

Collection from Wrap Around

This is a polite reminder to all parents using wrap around that our whole site is locked up at 6pm, so if you are close to 6pm for pick up you will need to leave the site promptly to allow the completion of this task. Ideally, parents should aim to arrive between 5.45pm and 6pm. We understand emergencies happen and so there is provision in the charging policy to apply an additional charge if we cannot lock up by 6pm.
